Right of Way Outdoor Advertising System - Transportation

Project Dates: 6/2006 through 7/2009

Project Cost: \$383,021

Project Objectives:

The objective of the project was to develop a stream-lined solution with an interface that is easy and obvious for supervisors, their crews and administrators to use from across the state. Significant benefits were:

- To meet the requirements from new legislation passed April 26, 2006 (SB 253) by the legislature.
- To reduce labor costs spent on administrative tasks by eliminating duplication of effort for the same data that is keyed into separate systems currently.
- An integrated workflow based on a consolidated data source helps KDOT and the applicant save time and reduce errors and rework. Automated, self-service application processing minimizes the need for the agency to input and manage client data.
- To work towards a paperless environment by interfacing with KDOT's document management system.
- And finally, allow an easily configurable solution, to support KDOT's business model, rules, and processes.
