Acquire and Implement Commercial Vehicle Information Exchange Window - TRCC – Kansas Highway Patrol

Project Dates: 9/2006 through 7/2008

Project Cost: \$488,863

Project Objectives:

Develop a Kansas CVIEW application and associated interfaces to perform the following functions:

- Collect and route interstate credential status information to Safety and Fitness Electronic Records (SAFER), including International Registration Plan (IRP), Interstate Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA), Unified Carrier Registration (UCR), inter- and intrastate motor carrier information.
- Receive periodic downloads from the SAFER database to support manual queries from credentialing, screening and safety personnel and automated queries from various credentialing systems.
- Provide for the electronic exchange of interstate carrier and vehicle credential data between state source systems, users and SAFER.
