Revenue– Kansas Apportioned International Registration System Replacement/ Performance and Registration Information System Management Requirements (KAIR/PRISM)

Project Objectives

The overall objective of this project was to enhance the State of Kansas IRP system through the implementation of a Kansas Apportioned Registration System (KARDS) that met the following objectives:

- Build a fully integrated, sustainable information system for Kansas Department of Revenue based upon effectiveness and efficiency.
- Provide one common business system to support a unified Motor Carrier business model for Kansas Department of Revenue.
- Build a unified web-based point of entry for all members of the motor carrier industry.
- Utilize the replacement of aged application as an opportunity to re-think past workflow procedures and business processes in order to streamline Motor Carrier Bureau operations and provide efficient, secure and user-friendly self-service access to motor carrier information and registration services for a motor carrier company, Kansas State motor carrier and enforcement staff, and multi-state jurisdictions.
- Provide secure and reliable system that is easy to use and maintain.
- Permit sophisticated data analyses for use in decision-making.
- Provide Motor Carrier Bureau and the motor carrier industry the ability to enter and process business transactions and to directly access core data.
- Enable apportioned and registration data to be entered and edited and be shared across the enterprise system.
- Provide additional business functionality.
- Assure system wide security.
- Provide a secure environment to support multi-tiered authentication across the enterprise system.
- Reduce manual work and paperwork through the use of electronic solutions.
- Increase productivity by identifying processes that can be effectively streamlined, such as the elimination of redundant data entry.
- Receive CVISN (Commercial Vehicle Information Systems and Networks) Level 1 Compliant certification.
- Implement PRISM (Performance and Registration Information Systems Management) in Kansas
