- Standardize the business processes across the State of Kansas to ensure quality and consistency of service.
- Reduce the duplicate data entry for the field staff.
- Provide a stable platform for the protection and retention of the data.

- Support of SRS Business Goal: Vulnerable adults are protected from abuse, neglect, and exploitation.
- Support of SRS Business Goal: Family and individuals have access to support and services necessary.
- Remove need for Outlook email system use as a documentation transfer/repository.
- Assist in checking prior reports of substantiated reports of abuse/neglect throughout the state.
- Improve ability to consistently apply and implement CFS and APS program policy and procedure statewide.
