COURSE DESCRIPTION

Agile Project Management officially began in 2001 and has become a popular project management approach. This two-day course examines the focus of energizing, empowering, and enabling project teams to provide customer value in a very efficient manner. Examine the value and process of actively involving the customer in the project. Explore the actions of responding to change in the project while focusing on delivering high customer value. Students will use discussion, cases, and group activities to facilitate the course.

- Identify success factors, principles and general practices of agile project management
- Examine the roles of the project manager, project team, and customer in agile project management
- Examine strategies of agile project management
- Analyze the estimating and scheduling in agile project management
- Analyze the tracking and communication in agile project management
- Analyze the risk and changes in agile project management
- Examine an agile project management model
