



Business Process Modeling

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This half-day introductory course will focus on the basics of Business Process understanding. The class is for Developers, Business Analysts, Business Architects, or IT or Business Managers that want to understand the basics of how to use business process clarity to improve how technology can help business improve efficiencies and effectiveness.

Process modeling is the method used to clarify the business process and is the first step in improving the business process. This is different than the typical Database-Table-Screen-Report-interface that most people work with. Behind these processes are all that and more.
